Get picked up from Royal Geelong Yacht Club at 8.00 am and enjoy a drive through farm land of the Western district on route to the famous 12 Apostles and Shipwreck coast. There will be some walking along coastal paths so suitable footwear should be worn. Lunch will be in Port Campbell where there is a good selection of cafes and eateries, or bring your own.
